

Chemical Name	<i>Polypropylene-polyethylene copolymer</i>
Physical state and appearance	<i>Multiwall sheet, with cell core between a solid bottom and top layer thickness : 3 - 4,5 mm / weight : 600 - 1500 g/m²</i>

Melting point	<i>160-175 °C</i>
Softening range	<i>145-155 °C</i>
Decomposition temperature	<i>> 300 °C</i>
Reactions with other materials	<i>Chemically inert material, no special precautions required</i>

Storage	<i>It is required to store at ambient temperature, protected from sunlight, and away of any inflammable material.</i>
Handling & precautions	
Handling	<i>Bicell[®] is a polymeric substance with high molecular weight & its handling involves no risk for the health of operators.</i>
Inhalation	<i>No emission of dangerous fumes at room temperature.</i>
Ingestion	<i>The resin itself is considered to be physiologically inert, but certain additives could be harmful. Avoid inhalation.</i>

Auto ignition temperature	<i>> 360 °C</i>
Combustion properties	<i>H₂O and CO₂ will be formed (Bicell[®] non flame-retardant)</i>
Fire extinguishing agents	<i>Water, fog, foam, CO₂, powder, etc...</i>
Toxicological information	<i>Bicell[®] is biologically inert and does not harm the environment. The used pigments are formed without any heavy metal. On demand additives can be added, suitable for food contact.</i>
Disposal information	<i>Scrap materials can be disposed off at approved landfill tips or can be disposed off by incineration under approved conditions. Advice on the preferred method should be obtained by the local authorities or waste disposal officers.</i>
Re-use information	<i>Bicell[®] can easily be recycled with other PP/PE-based products</i>
